Payment in full can be made by mailing a check or money order directly to Countryside Christian Academy. Monthly payments will be automatically deducted from a designated checking or savings account on your choice of the 5th or the 20th of the month. You may also use AMEX, Discover or MasterCard. FACTS will charge your account a one time enrollment fee. Once you have signed your financial agreement with the school office you may enroll in the FACTS Program. This can be done online. RenWeb

Our RenWeb School Management Software gives you, the busy parents, the opportunity to get more involved in your child's academic progress and future success, all via internet!

RenWeb is a private and secure website that has been set up for our school to allow you to see complete information specific to your child. You can view your child's grades, attendance, homework and conduct, as well as other useful school information. You can also communicate with teachers and other school staff online whenever necessary. All you need is internet access and to keep us updated on your current email address.

Curriculum

Kindergarten uses the Abeka curriculum, same as the preschool. The Kindergarten program is enhanced through our extra curricular classes including P.E., art, technology, music and Spanish.

Dress Code

CCA has a “standard of dress.” The purpose of our dress code is to encourage an environment that is conducive to learning. Uniforms are not included in tuition. Students are required to purchase uniforms from Sports Katz, and they are required to wear the school’s colors (grey, Kelly green, black or white) and logo (Uniform shirts must be purchased at Sports Katz). Uniform bottoms must be purchased from Sports Katz or be an exact match in color and style. Students may wear a uniform shirt or a CCA dress down shirt on Monday. The last Friday of the month is “Privilege Dress Down Day.” This will be announced. Students who have earned privilege dress down day may wear standard blue jeans and a shirt/blouse of their choice.

Lunch Program

Students may bring lunch from home or use the hot lunch program. Hot lunches are ordered for one month at a time and are purchased only through RenWeb. Lunch is \$3.50 and comes with a bottled water. The lunch period is 30 minutes.

Extended Care

CCA does offer morning and afternoon care. Morning care is 7:00-8:10am. Afternoon care is 3:00-6:00pm. Extended care is not included in tuition. The normal school day is 8:30am-3:00pm.
